

MILLER, Tevie Harold [UNTD NONSUCH 1945] (1928 - 1996) Age: 68

Tevie Miller crossed the bar on August 21, 1996, in Edmonton, AB, at the age of 68, 4 months after a diagnosis of pancreatic cancer.

He was promoted to A/SLT RCN(R), sen. 1 Sept '48, O-51874, attached to NONSUCH and was Ret'd as a SLT the following year.

Following in his father's footsteps, he was a Lawyer by trade and was ultimately the Associate Chief Justice of the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta from 1984 - 1993.

He was also the 13th Chancellor of the University of Alberta, from 1986 - 1990. It is also noteworthy that the 15th Chancellor (1994 - 1998) was fellow NONSUCH UNTD Lou Hyndman. Upon Tevie Miller's passing, his achievements were read into the record of the Alberta Legislature by MLA Laurie Decore, himself a fellow NONSUCH UNTD.

Tevie Miller had numerous other significant appointments, amongst which;

Chairman of the Board - Banff School of Advanced Management
President - U of A Alumni Association
President - United Way of Edmonton
Chairman - City of Edmonton Community Foundation
President - Edmonton Symphony Society
President - Jewish Community Council
President - Edmonton Bar Association
Director - Edmonton Eskimos

In that latter capacity in the late 1970s, the Esks won 3 straight Grey Cups and thus Tevie Miller was probably the only Judge to wear a Grey Cup ring, but not the only UNTD to do so; Nick Volpe [UNTD YORK 1944] was on the Argos 1950 Grey Cup winning team.
