

"One of the greatest public servants in Canadian history" (Ottawa Citizen). UNTD Cadet **Senator Michael Pitfield** resigned from the Senate on June 1 at 72 y/o because of ill health associated with Parkinson's Disease. As the youngest ever Clerk of the Privy Council (Prime Minister Trudeau's Deputy Minister) he was the key person to engineer the patriation of the Constitution in 1982 which included the Charter of Rights and Freedoms (with which he also played a very significant role in compiling). More importantly he was the President of the UNTD Gunroom Mess at HMCS Carleton circa 1967.
