

Michael Harold Rayner (UNTD CARLETON '61-'64 U-1696) SLT (Ret'd) 1943-2004

Michael Rayner, a CA, held prominent financial positions in the Fed Gov't and private sector.

He was the Acting Auditor-General of Canada in '80-'81 and Comptroller General of Canada, 1985-87.

He was also active in the Anglican Church.

1st summer '62 - Restigouche Division

2nd summer '63 - Huron Division - C/C - Runner-up Best 2nd year Cadet Overall

3rd summer '64 - West Coast

He was the son of iconic VADM Herbert Sharples Rayner, the last Chief of the Naval Staff from 1960-64.

NLCC ADMIRAL RAYNER was formed in his honour in Victoria 1960, while he was RADM and FOPC.

That Corp now meets on Admiral Rd in Esquimalt.

The Sept '09 UNTD Newsletter featured a story that mentions Michael Rayner placing a Plaque at the English Cemetery on San Juan Island in 1964.

Many on this list will have known/know of Michael Rayner and his very premature death at the age of 60, at home in Ottawa, was only recently pointed out to me by John MacFarlane.
