

WALLACE, Edward Hugh (Ed) [UNTD CHIPPAWA '44 - V93186] (1927- 2002) Age: 75

WALLACE - Rev. Edward H. On July 15, 2002 age 75, while on his daily visit to Grouse Mountain. He graduated from U. of Manitoba and taught school in Arrowhead before entering Wycliffe College where he attained a degree in Theology. Ed ministered in Trail and Winnipeg, where he met and married Almeda; Fergus, Ont.; Williams Lake and the Chilcotin; Calgary; and most recently, St. Stephens, West Vancouver and Friday Harbor, Wash. Predeceased by Almeda (1985), survived by his daughters Susan (Greg) McGuigan, and Kathleen (Andrew) Davis, and grandchildren Sean , Matthew, Peter and Alexandra. Ed served for many years as Naval Reserve Chaplain at HMCS Tecumseh and HMCS Discovery. He was an active Kiwanian, past president of the University Club, and member of the Vancouver Club. He loved books and music; he played the piano all his life; he enjoyed meeting new people and loved good conversation. Thank you to the North Vancouver RCMP, the North Shore Rescue and Grouse Mountain for their compassion and efficiency. Memorial service to be held Monday, July 22, 2002 at 2 pm at St. Stephens Anglican Church. 885-22nd St. West Vancouver. Ed was Commissioned as a SLT RCN(R), Sen. 6 Feb '48, O-75692, attached to CHIPPAWA.

He was Commissioned as a Chaplain Class II, Sen. 17 Nov '53, O-75692, attached to STAR

He was Chaplain at STAR from then to at least 1960 and was at TECUMSEH by 1965.

A highly reportable event occurred on Feb 11 '83. Rev Ed Wallace performed a service on the Passing of James Sinclair, Margaret Trudeau's father. The 3 kids were with her, but not Pierre. This was at St Stephen's Anglican Church, West Van, where Wallace was the Rector from 1977 to 1988, when he Ret'd. So, unbeknownst to our current PM, a UNTD officiated at the Memorial Service for his maternal grandfather.

Ed Wallace also took command of Holy Trinity Anglican Church in White Rock, BC, for 6 months, in 1991, upon the sudden passing of their Rector.

It was while looking into the details of the passing of SLT Mark Kenneth Lyons (ROUTP '69) on Oct 11, 1970, that it was remarked by Bob White that Ed Wallace officiated at that Service, which prompted us to discover his own passing. The information on Mark Lyons was in turn brought to our attention by Al Blackwood. Separate messaging on that event will follow.
