"Adelman, Allan G., Toronto; University of Toronto, 1961; internal medicine; FRCPC; former physician, Mount Sinai Hospital; associate professor, University of Toronto. Died May 11, 1999, aged 62; survived by his wife, Safiya, and 5 children."

Became an MD, U of T '61 and was a Cardiologist.
