Walter Bulani crossed the bar on October 21, 2014 in London, ON at the age of 85. Walter grew up in Biggar, SK where the family had an Agro business. By the Fall of 1946 he was at USask and in the UNTD.

In the Spring of '49 as a Senior Cadet, he received an NRC Bursary to pursue an MSc at USask. He was commissioned shortly thereafter as an Ordnance A/SLT in the Reg Force, O-10243 and promoted to Ord LT RCN, sen. 1 Jan '52, attached to DONNACONA. At that time he was at McGill working on a PhD. He attended an Ordnance Officers Qualifying Course in late 1953. His Thesis in 1955 acknowledged the financial support of both the NRC and the RCN. He had also spent some time at NADEN that year. By 1959 he was on staff at UWO in London, ON as a Chemical Engineering professor, retiring as such in 1986.

In a nod to modern times, one of his sons is an accomplished actor who amongst other things has appeared as an Elvis Impersonator in theatrical productions in the SW Ontario region.
