Passed away peacefully on January 27, 2009, just short of his 83rd birthday. Dad and Mom retired to Kelowna, BC in 1994, where he continued his involvement with the Knights of Columbus at St. Theresa's and was recognized as Knight of the Year. Dad enjoyed playing golf and bridge, spending time with grandchildren, skiing, watching football on TV, bike riding, travelling and Tim Horton's coffee.
