Died quietly in his sleep early on Friday, February 15, 2013 at the Etobicoke General Hospital. Born January 8, 1932 in Maracaibo, Venezuela; educated in Jamaica, then Ridley College in St. Catharines, Ontario and Trinity College, University of Toronto. He is held in loving memory by his sons, Tony and Jim; his daughter-in-law, Anne; his grandsons, Michael, David, Jack and Greg; his wife, Sandra; his sister-in-law, Donna and her daughter, Kate. Several generations of students will recall a memorable business education teacher, particularly from William Lyon Mackenzie Collegiate. There will be a private family service at the funeral home. John had 3 UNTDA summers: 1952 (East), 1953 (West), 1954 (West).

He graduated from Trinity College, U of T, with a BA in 1954.

He was promoted to SLT(S) RCN(R), sen. 1 May '54, O-14344, attached to YORK, then to LT(S), sen. 1 May '56. By 1960 he was on the Ret'd List.

He was a Charter Member of the UNTDA Association of Upper Canada when it formed in 1988 and was still a member when it transitioned into the national UNTDA in 2001.

He was a well respected teacher at William Lyon Mackenzie Collegiate Institute in Downsview, which is one of, if not the top-rated high school in the GTA.
