He had a substantial career in the Federal Civil Service, including:

Assistant Deputy Minister - Health and Welfare Canada 1973 - 1979

Deputy Clerk of the Privy Council – Canada 1979 - 1982

Deputy Minister - National Defence – Canada - App't by PM Trudeau Nov 1 '82 - 29 May '89

In the summer of 1990, back in the PCO, he found himself by default, the senior-most Gov't official in town when the Oka Crisis broke out. It was he who put together the management team that ultimately stabilized the situation.

Because of his experience in the Privy Council, he was named as an Advisor to the Gomery Royal Commission (2004 - 06) looking into the Federal Gov't Quebec Sponsorship Scandal.
