DIAMOND, Frederick William (Fred) (1935 - 2011) Age: 76

Much beloved and dearly missed by his family, Frederick William Diamond died Sunday, July 24, 2011 at his Oshawa home. Fred is being remembered as a true gentleman – smart, kind, witty, and totally committed to his family. He is survived by his wife, Nancy; daughter Susan (Suzie) of Guelph; and two grandsons, Verdi and Seth. He is also survived by his sister, Elizabeth and her husband Cliff Rowe of Lovell, Maine; and brother-in-law, Ross Darling and his wife Marie of Fredericton, New Brunswick. His dedication to and support of his family were absolute and much

appreciated. Born July 9, 1935 in Montreal, Quebec, he was the son of the late Frederick William Diamond and Evelyn Marie Broadbelt Diamond. Fred graduated high school in Shawinigan Falls, Quebec where he proved himself as a highly accomplished public speaker. A graduate of the University of New Brunswick and a Professional Engineer, Fred married Nancy Lynn Darling on July 4, 1964 in Christ Church Cathedral, Ottawa, Ontario. After spending twelve years in Montreal, the family moved to Oshawa in 1977 where he established an area office as the Manager with RoyNat Limited. Fred's caring and prudent nature allowed him to be a trusted advisor in the financial services sector as he ensured that his clients were well informed and understood the decisions they were making. Fred was a Fellow of the Canadian Securities Institute and was active in the community, serving as a member and President of the Greater Oshawa Chamber of Commerce, a member of the Oshawa Rotary Club, a director of the Canadian Automotive Museum, and a member of the Oshawa Golf Club.
