Age 91 of Dartmouth, passed away peacefully on November 7, 2017 in Parkstone Enhanced Care.

Commander in the armed forces for over 25 years. After military retirement he taught at Dartmouth Vocational, and NSIT. He was a founding member of the Halifax Royal Astronomer Society. He was appointed as a Naval Cadet (UNT D) RCN(R) 1948. In 1948 he served in HMCS Scotian for UNT D. He was appointed as an A/Instructor Sub-Lieutenant RCN(R) (With seniority dated 06/02/1950) [O-55814]. He was appointed as an Instructor Sub-Lieutenant RCN(R). (Transferred to RCN). He was appointed as an Instructor Lieutenant RCN (With seniority dated 06/02/1952). He was appointed as an Instructor Lieutenant-Commander RCN (With seniority dated 06/02/1960). In October 1965 he was serving at CDLS, Washington, DC.

Given his age and promotion dates, he entered the UNT D at least by 1947, if not earlier. He would not have appeared in Navy Lists as a Cadet though until the Fall of 1948.
